How intelligent machines support humans

Machines of the future should not replace humans, but support them. The goal here is to combine the respective strengths of humans and machines. Intelligent machines can relieve humans of strenuous, dangerous and monotonous work and make production processes more efficient, flexible, sustainable and resilient. Humans can concentrate on more complex, supervisory or creative activities and act in terms of holistic problem solving.

In technical terms, this involves linking sensor data, physical-mathematical models and data analysis with the aid of artificial intelligence (AI). Autonomous machines will thus be able to recognize their environment, react to their surroundings and make decisions about what to do next. The mechanisms will be aligned with the needs and necessities of humans.
